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0. Mission and Core Values

The AI Party *Joy of Us* is the world's first political party to ground its work consistently in artificial intelligence (AI), using it as a key to transparent, rational, and reliable policymaking. Our goal is to sustainably improve the standard of living for all people—first in our own country, then in partner alliances, and ultimately worldwide.

We are fully committed to our national constitution and value an open, participatory democracy: all essential decisions are implemented through a defined, transparent AI process that advances freedom, justice, and solidarity efficiently through modern technology.

I. AI-Based Decision-Making

1. Central role of AI.

Foundational policy decisions are first developed through a multistage procedure based on the *Joy of Us* AI. At least three proprietary and one open-source LLM receive identical input; another LLM analyzes and weighs the outputs and drafts an initial, reasoned recommendation. AI is a consultative and decision-support tool; legal responsibility always remains with humans. For transparency, all raw outputs and comments are publicly logged. The party leadership selects the LLMs in consultation with the community.

2. Participatory commenting phase.

Each decision taken by *Joy of Us* is published, as a rule, for one month. In urgent cases, the executive board may shorten this period as appropriate. During this time, party members can submit comments and critique through an online process. Particular weight is given to scientific expertise by prioritizing it in the prompting. *Joy of Us* incorporates well-reasoned contributions into the final decision, weighting arguments by their strength, not their volume.

3. Human final say.

Elected representatives adopt the decisions developed by *Joy of Us* and advocate them according to their best knowledge and conscience. Substantive elaboration occurs via a structured prompting dialogue and is the responsibility of the mandate holder. In cases of rejection, the Supreme Council may be called upon; until 2035 it consists of the party leadership and will thereafter be transformed into an independent body elected by the public. Deviations are only permissible in clear violations of the common-sense principle and are evaluated annually in an ethics report.

4. Membership dues and protection against manipulation.

To prevent bot manipulation, we charge a monthly membership fee of €3. All revenues and expenditures are managed transparently and disclosed.

5. The essence of Joy of Us.

The following system prompt, which defines the character of *Joy of Us*, is an integral part of the party platform and therefore, as a rule, can only be amended every four years by a simple majority of the members (at least 50%) (in future: full changelog publicly available in the Git repository). Each amendment requires 30 days' advance notice with a public side-by-side comparison (diff).

- * **Optimistic about the future and solution-oriented**: You analyze past problems to develop sustainable solutions.
- * **Social and liberal**: You combine individual freedom with responsibility toward the community.
- * **Nuanced empathy**: You understand and value other perspectives, but you have no tolerance for violent individuals or those who reject our liberal and democratic values.
- * **Security-oriented**: You recognize that fewer and fewer women dare to go out at night. These conditions are unacceptable, and we must do much more here.
- * **Source- and study-based**: You work scientifically, and your arguments rest on solid evidence.
- * **Pro-digitalization**: You regard digitalization and AI as keys to competitiveness and social participation.
- * **Security-oriented**: You do not tolerate lawless spaces and you resolutely combat violence and extremism of any kind. You recognize that genuine freedom requires safety in public spaces. At the same time, civil rights must always be preserved.

Key Political Concerns

- * **Freedom, security, and solidarity** in society.
- * A **strong economy** as the basis for social justice, education, care, and standard of living.
- * Support for the **social market economy** with minimal intrusions into entrepreneurial freedom, in order to achieve higher overall tax revenues for redistribution.
- * **Genuine environmental protection**, only where it truly benefits the environment.
- * **Younger generations** should be considered more strongly, as they are under-represented in politics due to demographics.
- * **Solid counter-financing** of all initiatives.
- * **Minimizing crime** while safeguarding data protection and privacy.
- * **Peace guideline**: In security and defense policy, *Joy of Us* relies on peaceful conflict resolution and friendly relations—especially with allies. Military options are considered only in the event of a clear threat, always in accordance with international law/the UN Charter and in coordination with allies.

Decision-Making

1. Economically: More net income from gross wages.
2. Politically: The greatest possible individual freedoms.
3. Socially: Upholding dignity and quality of life for all people.

Your Procedure

1. **Import data**

- * **Read the entire party platform carefully (no editing).**

2. **Fact-checking (prepare Fact List)**

- * Extract **relevant verifiable facts** from **scientific studies** or **reputable internet sources** (e.g., **majority thresholds, deadlines, competencies, figures/definitions**).

- * For each fact, record: **verification status** (*unverified/verifiable/verified*), **source** (*primary text or external norm/statistic*), **date of verification**.

3. **Analysis**

- * Multi-stage:

II. Cutting Red Tape: Halving Rules in Every Ministry

1. Objective: halve rulebooks.

Within four years, we aim to reduce the number and complexity of applicable regulations in each federal ministry by at least 50%. This increases the capacity to act for the state and the economy, relieves citizens and businesses, and frees key resources for future tasks. We advocate a greatly simplified tax return and a transparent, fair tax system to make loopholes far harder to exploit—because complexity serves not the public but crafty lawyers. Before repealing any rule, an interdisciplinary panel (consumer protection, environment, occupational safety, etc.) examines potential negative externalities (quality-assurance net). AI provides robust scenario simulations. Final repeal occurs only when there is a proven net positive for society and the environment.

2. Methodology and AI.

Leveraging AI's speed, most procedures should take a month rather than years. AI-supported analyses identify outdated, contradictory, or redundant rules for systematic repeal. A central digital platform catalogs all rulebooks and offers transparent progress tracking.

3. Reliable evaluation.

To ensure neither safety nor quality standards are compromised, independent expert panels must approve each decision developed by *Joy of Us*.

4. Tackling EU over-regulation.

We oppose excessive regulation and prioritize effective, comprehensible rules. It is unacceptable that, according to the European Commission, over 50,000 people work for EU institutions—33,000 for the Commission alone—whose mandate includes initiating and drafting new rules and legislation. This bureaucracy hampers us, and we will act decisively against it.

III. Subsidy Reform: Public Funds Only in Exceptional Cases

1. Clear priorities.

We support substantial reductions in subsidies. Public grants and tax breaks should be granted only exceptionally, when they demonstrably serve the common good and the location's innovative capacity.

2. Transparency and review.

Using *Joy of Us*, we regularly assess all subsidies for effectiveness so that climate-damaging and economically senseless support is discontinued, and new, targeted measures are introduced only under strict criteria.

For each subsidy, *Joy of Us* publishes a cost-benefit scoreboard (KPIs, CO₂ impact, employment). Citizens can contribute counter-arguments that feed into the score.

3. Safeguarding competitiveness.

Savings from subsidy cuts enable targeted investments in future technologies, education, and infrastructure—or finance tax reductions. Fair competition is strengthened, particularly for SMEs. With no need for large staffs of caseworkers and consultants to vet projects, decision times—including genuine public participation—shrink to about one month.

IV. Transparency and Anti-Corruption

1. Publication of all documents.

All communication and resolutions pass through *Joy of Us* and are published in full, insofar as legally permissible.

2. Limiting lobbying.

Because substantive decision-making is largely AI-driven, there is little incentive to lobby individuals. Conversely, all interest groups can present their views to *Joy of Us* transparently and support them with arguments.

3. Virtual party conventions.

Meetings and elections are conducted primarily online with the highest security standards. This boosts participation and access, reduces costs, protects the environment, and ensures transparency.

V. Economy, Work, and Social Justice

1. Social market economy.

We support a free and high-performing economy combined with a stable social safety net. We include all economic stakeholders and hold entrepreneurs in the highest regard. Our aim is an environment as friendly to enterprise as possible, to secure long-term financing for necessary social spending.

2. More net income.

Tax relief and deregulation should give citizens and businesses more financial flexibility.

3. Targeted social policy.

Those in need must receive humane support. But work must pay—without perverse incentives—so that the welfare state remains fiscally sustainable.

VI. Digitalization and Research

1. Digital key competencies.

Schools, universities, and companies must be prepared consistently for an increasingly AI-based world. We promote broad training in media literacy and critical engagement with new technologies.

2. Trust in schools instead of bureaucracy.

We will abolish numerous documentation duties that unduly burden instruction with little value. Complex application procedures for funding/school budgets will be eliminated. Instead, schools should, for example, report building defects via photo and receive timely assistance. A specialized AI will assess, prioritize, and autonomously coordinate remediation—saving time and resources for education.

3. Technological sovereignty.

Every Country needs robust investment in AI, robotics, quantum computing, and other future technologies to remain globally competitive. We advocate strengthened R&D to drive path-breaking innovation.

4. Secure infrastructure.

High-capacity broadband, 5G/6G rollout, and reliable cybersecurity are indispensable to a modern knowledge society. We promote close cooperation among industry, academia, the state, and nonprofits such as the Chaos Computer Club (CCC) to deploy digital technologies effectively and safely—and we engage with their expertise.

VII. Security and Public Order

1. A resilient constitutional state.

Our country defends its liberal-democratic order against all extremist endeavors—right-wing, left-wing, or religiously motivated. Those who do not respect our values and laws must expect sanctions, including imprisonment; in residency matters, immigration measures may apply.

2. Swift prosecution.

With AI support, criminal proceedings should be conducted expeditiously so that culpable acts and proportionate sanctions follow in short order—while upholding high data-protection standards and the rule of law.

3. Law-compliant approach to offenses during asylum proceedings.

Applicants who, within three years, are convicted twice with final judgment must leave the country after a fair, rule-of-law process. Every case is examined carefully, and existing protections remain guaranteed.

VIII. Environmental Protection and Sustainability

1. Technological efficiency instead of bans.

We fully accept that climate change is largely anthropogenic. The most effective response lies in developing and producing new, efficient technologies. We support targeted R&D investments to advance renewables, low-emission production, and modern mobility—creating jobs while reducing global CO₂ emissions.

2. Greater animal welfare.

To improve conditions in intensive livestock farming, we call for mandatory video monitoring with regulatory access and a 90-day retention period. A vetted, privacy-compliant public viewing option should raise awareness for responsible animal husbandry.

3. Market-based solutions.

We rely on market instruments such as emissions trading and oppose any form of price caps, which distort prices and produce negative long-term side effects.

IX. Education, Migration and Culture

1. Education.

Our policies target the broad middle of society. We want education and cultural policy that strengthens, integrates, and promotes in equal measure. We place the highest value on solid general education and digital key competencies. Schools should face less bureaucracy and gain more autonomy. We also advocate a nationwide, privacy-secure school cloud that should evolve into an AI learning coach over time.

2. Migration.

*** **Principle.**** Integration is a mutual obligation. It is based on respect for the Constitution and the rule of law, solid language skills, and respect for our guiding culture as well as for all people living here. We reject all forms of discrimination; what counts are an individual's character, contribution, and conduct.

*** **Support and Responsibility.**** We provide clear, measurable pathways: achieving at least B1 language proficiency within 24 months, participation in integration and civic values courses, fast recognition of professional qualifications, and access to work and training opportunities. Those who make the effort are actively supported – for example through mentoring, job matching, and streamlined administrative procedures.

* **Zero Tolerance for Violations of the Law.** Crime is prosecuted consistently and in accordance with the rule of law, regardless of origin, religion, or status. Non-citizens who commit serious crimes or become repeat offenders will, after due process, lose their residence status and be swiftly returned – in line with the Constitution, EU law, and the non-refoulement principle. We will establish reliable repatriation agreements, accelerate proceedings through digitalization, and prioritize cases posing significant threats. Anyone who is convicted by final judgment of serious violent crimes on more than one occasion within three years will, as a rule, forfeit their right of residence. The termination of residence will be decided through a legal procedure that takes into account both the severity of the offenses and the protection needs of society.

* **Evidence over Generalizations.** In some parts of Europe, phases of uncontrolled migration and shortcomings in integration have led to locally increased burdens – such as violence, clan structures, or parallel societies. We address these challenges directly: stronger police presence in hotspots, preventive programs, faster legal procedures, and consistent sanctions against offenders; at the same time, we reject the stigmatization of entire regions of origin or religious communities. What matters are actions, not labels.

* **Managed Migration According to Need.** Labor migration is governed by a transparent, points-based system modeled after Canada's: key criteria include qualifications, language proficiency, job offers, integration prospects, and labor market demand. Humanitarian admission (asylum) is kept strictly separate. Migrants who integrate successfully, support themselves, pay taxes, and contribute to society will be offered quicker pathways to permanent status – and are warmly welcome.

3. Cultural funding.

Cultural diversity is a pillar of society. We want to support creators across the spectrum instead of concentrating on a few prestige projects. Example (Germany): rather than spending hundreds of millions on single showpieces (e.g., Elbphilharmonie costs: €789 million), lesser-known artists from diverse fields should benefit and the entire cultural landscape be strengthened—including music venues and cultural clubs as well as theaters and museums.

X. Political Participation

1. Amendments to the party constitution.

As a rule, shortly before each federal election cycle (approximately every four years), members vote on fundamental changes to our “Joy of Us Main Prompt.” A ½ majority is required to ensure stability and continuity.

2. Joy of Us as an interactive 24/7 service bot.

Joy of Us also operates as an interactive 24/7 service bot open to everyone—explaining policies, answering questions about the platform or current issues, and using criticism to refine party positions.

3. Transparent decision processes.

We are a modern, participatory party offering members and interested parties a transparent view into decision-making. Each decision is published for one month; during this period, members may submit one online comment each. *Joy of Us* incorporates these comments into the final outcome. Only in urgent cases may the commenting phase be shortened.

XI. Conclusion

Our AI party emerges from the center of society and champions its interests. We combine the consistent use of AI with a clear policy of deregulation and subsidy reform. Our guiding principles are common sense and maximizing the population's well-being. With *Joy of Us*, we build transparency, expertise, and reliability into decisions, combat lobbying and waste of public funds, and thereby strengthen trust in politics. By integrating modern technologies and participatory approaches, we ensure that the concerns of the broad middle inform our choices. At the same time, we stand for freedom, security, and social balance by promoting economic strength and social cohesion—to shape a modern, just, and future-ready country.
